3. Hotels

The organizer is providing two official hotels for all delegations in order to facilitate the meetings, the registration and weigh-in of all athletes, as well as reasonable package prices for all participants.

The official hotels are

Scandic Triangeln and Scandic Malmö City

If a team chooses not to use the proposed official hotels the organizing committee will debit the team with 100 EUR per person for organizing costs related to the competition. Moreover, such a team will not benefit by any of the additional services (such as meals or transports etc.)

4. Transports

5. Right to participate and categories

Athletes must be presented and registered by their National Federation. Following 2010 JJIF TC and GA decision: **max 2 persons** per category are allowed.

All competitors must have a legal passport of the nation that they represent in the championships and sports passports of their respective nation!

6. Competition fees

Fighting system - 85 €/competitor

Duo system - 85 €/couple

Ne-Wasa system – 85 €/competitor

9. Referees

Each country should provide minimum 1 referee for up to 6 participants, 2 for up to 15 participants, and 3 for 15 participants and more. An 800 Euro fee will be requested for not having the right number of referees and collected by the JJEU organizing federation on the spot (conditioned for participation before the draw). This rule doesn't apply to new members during the first 3 years.

Referees should attend the briefing meeting before the championships start.

17. Financial conditions

The price of accommodation (**with full board**) is:

Single room: 120 €/pers/night

Double room: 85 €/pers/night

Room with three beds: 75 €/pers/night

Room with four beds: 70 €/pers/night

Room with five beds: 65 €/pers/night

The 4 and 5 bed rooms are available in a limited amount!

Travel expenses and organization are the responsibility of the participating countries. The cost for the accommodation and the participation must be paid by each federation to the organizer.
